Crossover Deadline: Thursday, May 8

Bills eligible to be filed in 2025 with no deadlines:

(1) Redistricting bills for House, Senate, Congress, or local entities.

(2) Ratification of amendments to the Constitution of the United States.

(3) Bills providing for action on gubernatorial nominations or appointments.

(4) Appointments by the General Assembly.

(5) Adjournment resolutions.

(6) Bills introduced on the report of the House Committees on Appropriations, Finance, or Rules.
